EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Please (tick) the appropriate box when adding that item to your bag.

ALL ITEMS ARE REQUIRED

- Ball brauser OR spray bottle OR plastic bottle with at least 10 small holes
- Dish washing soap (mild detergent, avoid strong colour)
- Block of olive oil soap or similar
- Small plastic container (ice cream container) if using a ball brauser
- Rolling pin approx. 50cm long and 5cm diameter **OR** plumber's plastic pipe **OR** wooden dowel (**Not** a pool noodle as it is too big!)
- Soft plastic supermarket bag (scrunchable) or freezer bag
- Bubble wrap 50cm square **or** rippled drawer liner of the same size
- Hand towel
- Bath towel
- Nylon tulle 60cm square
- Plastic bucket or bag to take home any wet items
- Sponge to mop up any excess water
- Disposable latex gloves if hands are sensitive to water or soap
- Scissors
- Sewing needle to sew up stuffing hole in body
- Tape measure
- Notebook and pen

Food: Please bring your own lunch and snacks. Tea and coffee will be provided.

Included in the price of the workshop is a materials kit.

On the day of the workshop, you will be supplied with a kit which contains all the materials required to make your own critter.

Contents of kit include:

- ✓ Wool nepps
- ✓ Roving 4 colours
- ✓ Stuffing for body
- ✓ 1 pair of eyes
- ✓ 1 x 26 gauge florist wire
- ✓ 3 x 20 gauge florist wire
- ✓ 1 x Princely crown
- ✓ 1 x body resist
- ✓ 1 x polyfoam square to make a second small resist
- ✓ 1 x 50cm square 1mm polyfoam wrap

Other items made available for your use during the workshop include:

- ✓ Other mystery adorning fibres
- ✓ Sewing thread in a range of colours
- ✓ Assorted beads
- ✓ Silk hanky pieces
- ✓ Viscose fibre
